The Combined Support Maintenance Shop for the Vermont Army National Guard was a challenge and a privilege for The Burley Partnership to undertake. Some 60,000 square feet of program space was laid out to serve the varied equipment maintenance needs of the Army National Guard. The building includes a dedicated paint bay, welding shop, electronics workrooms, and three crane bays - one of which contains the largest crane in the State of Vermont. All of this was achieved in an attractive brick building, with massing which descends to human scale, and offers public spaces open to natural light.
