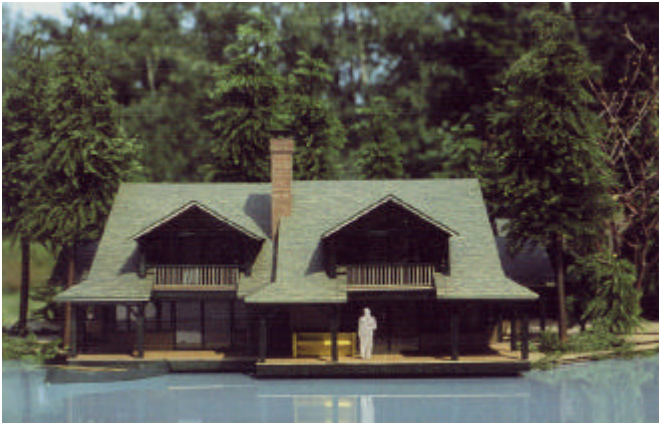

Design Model



This condominium project is located in a ski resort at the foot of Mount Mansfield, the highest peak in Vermont. The Mount Mansfield Corporation asked The Burley Partnership to plan and design a condominium development that would offer residents ski-on/ski-off access, views of Mount Mansfield, and an architectural style that embodies mountain living at its best.

The site plan clusters the units around a trout pond that is designed as part of the drainage system. Four of the units are on the pond's edge. The remaining units front on the Mountain Chair Lift. Residents can ski to the lift directly from their unit.

The architectural form is strongly influenced by the Adirondack park style. Shed roofs, generous overhangs, gabled porches, and uncomplicated, generous floor plans establish the architectural expression. The units range in size from 1,600 square feet with two bedrooms, to 2,100 square feet with four bedrooms
