



The design of this Florida House is an assemblage of one-story structures, each with a hipped clay-tile roof. Each roof eave is placed two feet away from the adjoining eave, with the space then bridged by clear glass skylights. These sky-lit slots create a sense of walking outdoors from one building to the next. The grid-pattern of natural daylight highlights linear plantings.
