This Private Residence is a Vermont retreat for a large family. The site is over forty acres, with space and facilities to accommodate a lifelong interest in horses. The approach from a long, curving drive gives the cluster of house, barns and sheds a real sense of privacy. At an elevation of 155 feet, the view of the mad River Valley and the crest of the Green Mountains is spectacular. The traditional design of the house and barns reflects their location in Vermont. The design is compatible with an 18<sup>th</sup> Century house that had been moved to this site from New Hampshire and which forms one wing of the house.
